

## **2015 TOC DRESS CODE**

All participants and guests

The following dress code is strictly enforced to ensure all players compete in appropriate attire.

1. NO tank tops, sleeveless shirts or any clothing with lewd or suggestive content is permitted in the Tournament Facility.
2. All players must present a clean and neat appearance.
3. Khaki's, slacks, nice jeans, capris or shorts need to be neat, clean and untorn. No cut-offs or ragged-edged hems on any shorts. Sweatpants are not allowed.
4. Closed toed shoes must be worn in the tournament hall at all times. No flip flops. No open toed sandals.
5. Hats and headgear that is neat, clean and untorn is allowed.
6. Clothing representing alternative darts programs such as but not limited to: NDA, DartsLive, ADA, Bud Light league and state events (state tournament shirts) is not allowed.
7. Clothing or accessories containing advertisements representing any product, service or company not sponsoring or associated with and approved by the PPD is not allowed. Excluding clothing benefiting charities alone.

Example 1, clothing representing any brand of WHISKEY or RUM other than Lord Calvert, Lady Bligh or brands affiliated with Luxco products is not allowed.

Example 2, clothing representing any dartboard manufacturer, other than Arachnid, is not allowed.

Example 3, clothing representing any darts products is not allowed.

Example 4, clothing representing any darts distributions company other than Horizon Darts is not allowed.

Example 5, clothing representing any apparel manufacturer other than Redeye Rhino (aka UTG) is not allowed.
